



## **PAINT YOUR SPACE CLASS OF 2021**

**Important – if you are going to use a space that was willed to you from a senior, come to GHS before August 19 and label the space as yours so it does not get painted over by someone else before you arrive on August 19! Make sure it is obvious.**

**Social Distancing Most be Followed.** Bring your mask for when you must be within 6 feet of someone.

GHS senior drivers can paint/personalize a parking space on campus. This option is available to seniors only. The space you select will be your assigned space for the year. Proceeds from this fundraiser will support the rewards and activities fund.

**Cost:** \$40 includes parking permit

**Application/Design Due:** Parking permit application, parking design and fee are due the day of the painting party. You must have a copy of your driver's license and insurance card with you. The office will be open if you need to make a copy.

**Painting Party:** August 19, 10 am to 6 pm  
(Rain date August 20, 10 am to 6 pm)

**End of the Year Requirement:** At the end of the year you can “will” your spot to another student who will pay the fee for the next year or you must paint over the design. (Due to Covid-19, you will have to paint over the spot currently there if you choose one that was painted last year.)

### **Guidelines for your design:**

Think of your space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval.

- ✓ No offensive language, pictures or symbols
- ✓ No “gang-related” symbols
- ✓ No flags
- ✓ No double meanings



Personalize your spot by creating a design that reflects your interests, shows your school spirit or is simply creative. Keep it classy and have fun with it. If you search “paint my space” or “parking spot ideas”, you will find a lot of ideas.

You must leave a 4 inch border between your design and the white parking lines.

### **What you will need:**

Water based exterior latex paint only.

- ✓ No reflective paint
- ✓ No oil based paints
- ✓ No fluorescent paint
- ✓ No spray paint
- ✓ No clear coat

4-inch tape to mark your border (Blue painters tape works well).

Paint rollers/brushes and a paint tray

### **Additional Suggested Materials, Tips and Hints:**

- Someone to help.
- Broom/blower to clear the space before you start painting
- Water-based primer or base coat for concrete can be used before you add your design
- Chalk to sketch your design
- Paint roller extension
- Rags or paper towels
- Old sheet or drop cloth to set paint cans on
- Bag for your trash
- Lawn chairs
- Water and snacks
- Sunscreen
- Save money on paint - Work with friends to buy and share paint. Look for paint on clearance or what might be leftover at your house.
